Day 1

Today, we are greeted by our professional Bianco tour guide and driver and begin our journey to the rocky shores of Maine. We will make plenty of comfort stops as we work our way to the Holiday Inn and Suites in East Syracuse, New York for our overnight stay.

Day 2

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we board the coach and begin our journey east to the Berkshires in western Massachusetts. We will stop for lunch on our own in the delightful town of Stockbridge, Massachusetts. We continue to York, Maine for a visit to the **Stonewall Kitchen Company Store**. This gourmet shop is filled with delicious jams, sauces, and all things blueberry. Check into the Anchorage Inn this evening. This beautiful beachfront hotel is located just steps away from Long Sands Beach and offers breathtaking ocean views. Dinner is included tonight at a local restaurant.

Day 3

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we hop on the coach for a short trip to the **Cape Neddick “Nubble Light” Lighthouse**. We will stop for pictures at the active lighthouse that is one of the most photographed lighthouses in the US. We continue north to Portland with a drive along Ocean Avenue in Kennebunkport where you will have a chance to see Walker’s Point – the Presidential estate of the Bush family. We arrive in Portland in time for lunch at a local restaurant. This

afternoon we set sail on a fully narrated **Harbor Lights and Sights Cruise**. Sit back as we cruise through Portland Harbor and Diamond Pass and take in the iconic lighthouses, scenic shorelines, and coastal wildlife. Next stop will be in **downtown Freeport** for shopping and dinner on your own. Be sure to visit the L.L. Bean store! Tonight, we check into the quiet and comfortable Fairfield Inn & Suites in Brunswick, ME for the next two nights.

Day 4

Enjoy another included breakfast at the hotel this morning before we journey to Bath and the **Maine Maritime Museum**. This 20-acre waterfront campus offers exhibits about Maine's maritime heritage and culture. Our next stop is **downtown Boothbay Harbor** for lunch and shopping on your own. This afternoon we visit the **Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens**. The gardens and landscape encompass nearly a mile of tidewater shoreline and are home to the giant trolls. Later this afternoon we return to the hotel to freshen up before heading out for an included dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 5

Another included breakfast awaits this morning at the hotel, and then we're off to the **Owl's Head Transportation Museum** featuring a world-class collection of pre-1940 aircraft, ground vehicles, and engines – where everything works. We will make a stop in **Belfast**, located at the mouth of the Passagassawakeag River for lunch and shopping on your own. This afternoon we will visit the **Fort Knox Historic Site** and **Penobscot Narrows Bridge Observatory**. Located on the west bank of the Penobscot River, Fort Knox is one of the best preserved military fortifications on the New England sea coast. The Penobscot Narrows Bridge and Observatory is the crown jewel of coastal Maine. The tallest public bridge observatory (taller than the Statue of Liberty) offers spectacular 360-degree views of the

Penobscot River and Bay, the Maine countryside, and distant mountains. Tonight, we arrive in Bangor and check into the Country Inn at the Mall for the next two nights. This laid-back hotel nestled on a leafy property is the perfect backdrop for a good night's rest. Dinner is included tonight at a local restaurant.

Day 6

Breakfast is included once again at the hotel this morning before we make our way to **Bar Harbor** where our first stop will be a delightful **Lobster Fishing and Seal Watch Cruise** in Frenchman Bay. For the first half of the cruise watch the experienced fishers haul in lobster traps as the professional naturalist answers all your questions about lobster fishing and marine wildlife. On the second half of the cruise, we will head to a small island to see the harbor and grey seals basking on the rocks and swimming in the nearby waters. Making our way to downtown Bar Harbor we will have time for lunch on your own. This afternoon our local step on guide joins us on board the coach for a 3 hour **guided tour of Acadia National Park** including a visit to the summit of Cadillac Mountain. Our included dinner tonight will be an authentic Lobster Bake with all the traditional fixings.

Day 7

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before sadly, we must say goodbye to Maine and begin our journey home. We stop at the **Mount Washington Cog Railway** for an excursion to the summit of Mount Washington. The 3-hour round-trip to the 6,288' summit of Mount Washington includes a layover where you can explore the Visitor Center, Rooftop Observation Deck, interactive weather museum, cafeteria and gift shop. Lunch will be on your own today in the cafeterias. From there we will continue on to Lincoln, NH where we will overnight at the Mountain Club on Loon. Dinner is included at a local restaurant this evening.

Day 8

Make your way to another included breakfast at our hotel this morning and prepare for our final day of activities. Our first stop in Waterbury, Vermont, where we will visit **Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory** to learn a little more about the famous ice cream. A short video will be followed by time to view the ice cream manufacturing from the observation deck and then a delicious sample. We then continue to Vermont's "Little Grand Canyon" – **Quechee Gorge** where we will have time to explore the Visitor Center and have lunch on your own at the snack bar. Following lunch, we journey south to Rockingham for a stop at the **Vermont Country**

Store. Explore the aisles filled with all things unique to New England. Tonight we will spend the night at the Sandstone Hollow Inn in Verona, New York. Shuttles run from the Inn to the **Turning Stone Casino** where you can try your hand at the different games if you choose.

Day 9

One final breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we board the coach and continue our journey home with fond memories of our Majestic Maine adventure. Thank you for travelling with Bianco!
